About MIRT

The Theological University of Kampen offers an English-taught 1-year Master's degree programme: Master of Intercultural Reformed Theology (MIRT) in which we welcome international and Dutch students. We believe that doing theology 'together with all the saints' (Eph. 3:18) is a valuable approach in and for our global world.

Already for many years it is attractive for theologians from inside and outside Europe to come to the TUK to study the Reformed heritage and famous Dutch representatives like Herman Bavinck and Abraham Kuyper. Till today Christians from Japan to the USA and Brazil are inspired by the Reformed worldview for all aspects of life. In the 'learning community' of the MIRT, we reflect on the intercultural contribution Reformed Theology can make for churches and theology worldwide.

The programme consists of one year of full-time residential studies in Kampen (60 ECTS credits). Following completion of the programme, you will receive a Master of Arts degree in Theology. For excellent students there are possibilities to embark on a PhD in Kampen.

Phase 1

General - 12.5 ECTS CREDITS

- Common Course: Hermeneutics for the Reformed Tradition
- Research Methodology
- Free Minor

Phase 2

Specialization - 30 ECTS CREDITS

- Intercultural Reading of the Scriptures
- Important Theologians in the Reformed Tradition
- Theory and Praxis of Doing Reformed theology Interculturally
- Actual Themes in Reformed and Neo-Calvinist theology
- Reformed worldview for Today

Phase 3

Master's Thesis - 17.5 ECTS CREDITS

- Become more deeply acquainted with Reformed and neo-Calvinist theology and tradition;
- Reflect on the relevance of Reformed theology in their own context;

- Study in Europe: the cradle of the Reformation.
